Following business was transacted in the meeting:

1. To read and confirm the previous meeting:

The minutes of the previous meeting held on Saturday, 10 May 2025 were read by Dr. Mugdha Joshi, IQAC Coordinator and the same were confirmed by the Committee.

2. To present report of the Director about various activities since the Committee met last.

The Director presented a comprehensive report covering following significant activities/achievements of the students and staff members:

- Certificate Programme in Banking & finance in Collaboration with Bajaj Finserve starting from 10 Dec'2025
- Celebration of various days of national importance such as Teacher's day, international youth day, yoga day, entrepreneurship day

3. To discuss about the various activities proposed by the Institute during the upcoming semester.

The members were informed that the Institute is planning to conduct following activities during the upcoming academic year:

- Seminars for students in collaboration with SPPU

- State Level Seminar for faculty members in collaboration with an external agency as Best Practice
 - Conduct of annual social week 'Abhivyakti' and Annual Day
 - Participation of students in various activities/events/competitions etc to ensure their overall development
 - Participation of faculty members in various conferences/seminars/workshops and writing/presenting the quality research papers.
 - Internship of the students for completion of their project reports in their II & IV semester.
- All the members expressed their satisfaction on the working of the Institute and appreciated the efforts of all the faculty members.

4. To discuss about reframing of Vision & Mission statement of the Institute.

Dr. Mugdha Joshi informed the members that in light of National Education Policy 2020 and NAAC reforms, the Gokhale Educations Society has directed all the colleges/institutes to revisit their vision and mission statements and reframe it, if necessary. The Director requested the members to provide their valuable suggestions on the same.

Col. Pravin Gadre suggested that the suggestions may be invited from a few alumni, CDC members, GB members etc and then the reframing can be finalized. His suggestion was adopted by all.

5. To inform the members about examination schedule of MBA-I & II.

Dr. Renu Thakur briefed the members that the internal exams of MBA I & II were conducted from 28 Oct to 4 Nov 2025.

She also informed that the University exams for MBA-I, Sem-I would be from 24/12/2025 to 10/01/2026 while for MBA-II, Sem-III would be from 03/01/2026 to 13/01/2026.

6. To discuss the details of Placement Cell & Research Centre of the Institute.

The Placement Coordinator of the Institute Dr. Sapna Patil informed the members that the e-Placement brochure of the Institute was released in the month of October 2025 and is hosted on the Institute website. She also briefed the members about the placement of 7 students till date.

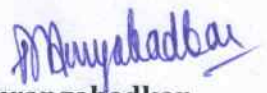
The members were informed about the various activities under research centre of the Institute such as admission status, progress report presentations, pilot study presentations etc.
